RE:	CBCSF Scholarship Applications

The Connecticut Building Congress Scholarship Fund (CBCSF) announces that it will once again be offering scholarships to graduating Connecticut high school students entering collegelevel programs in architecture, construction-related engineering, construction management, surveying, planning or other courses of study leading to associate, baccalaureate, or masters degrees in the construction field.

The awards will be given for academic merit, extracurricular activities, potential, and financial need. The scholarships may be renewable each year based on performance in school and available resources. The number of awards as well as the amounts may vary at the discretion of the CBCSF Board of Directors. In recent years, three to five new scholarships ranging from \$3,000 to \$4,000 per year have been awarded. Between new scholarships and renewals, the CBCSF is currently committed to a total of \$67,000 in scholarships to 20 young men and women during the current academic year.
