



CONNECTICUT BUILDING CONGRESS SCHOLARSHIP FUND CONTRIBUTION FORM

The Connecticut Building Congress Scholarship Fund (CBCSF) supports the young men and women who are pursuing an education in construction-related fields such as architecture, engineering, and construction management. Since its inception in 1976, the CBC Scholarship Fund has awarded scholarships totaling nearly \$1,000,000 to over 150 young men and women. For the 2026-2027 academic year, CBCSF is committed to funding 20 scholarship recipients in the amount of \$107,500. As these are multi-year scholarships, CBCSF is committed to \$304,500 through the spring of 2031. Past CBC Scholarship recipients have joined the industry at places including Centerbook Architects, Shawmut, WSP, BL Companies, HNTB, Thornton Tomasetti, e2 Engineers, and many others.

The cost of a college education continues to sky-rocket. To help offset these rising costs, the CBCSF Board of Directors has made it a priority to increase both the number and value of scholarships awarded. In so doing, the need for funding has grown. Historically, the majority of the funds were raised through the proceeds from the Connecticut Building Congress' Annual Golf Outing. While this remains the largest individual annual contribution to the CBCSF, with our ambitious goals, we now rely more than ever on additional contributions from A/E/C industry leaders like you. We are hoping that we can rely on your financial generosity as we strive to support the future leaders of our industry. Contributors of \$2,000 or more will be eligible to participate in the ceremonial check presentation during the CBC Annual Project Team Awards banquet.
